17 AN ACT to Require the Load on Gravel
18 Trucks to be Covered When Operating on a
19 Public Way.

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
22 follows:

23 29 MRSA §1752, as amended by PL 1977, c. 32, is
24 further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph
25 to read:

26 No person may operate or cause to be operated
27 upon any public way a vehicle with a load of gravel,
28 sand or crushed rock, unless the load is covered or
29 otherwise secured or confined to prevent any portion
30 of the load from falling from or spilling out of the
31 vehicle.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this bill is to require that any
vehicles hauling a load of gravel, sand or rock cover
the load or secure it to prevent spilling.

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
