17 RESOLVE, Authorizing the Conveyance of a
18 Certain Unused Building and Land Owned
19 by the State to the Town of Wells for
20 \$10,000.

22 Conveyance of building and grounds authorized.
23 Resolved: That the Attorney General is authorized to
24 convey to the Town of Wells for the sum of \$10,000
25 all the state's interest in land located on Route 1
26 in the Town of Wells, including the building thereon
27 formally used as a state police barracks, and pres-
28 ently unoccupied.

29 STATEMENT OF FACT

30 The purpose of this resolve is to enable the Town
31 of Wells to acquire a certain parcel of land approxi-
32 mately 100 feet by 200 feet and the building thereon
33 24 feet by 38 feet in size, on Route 1 in the Town of
34 Wells. This land and building is owned by the State

1 and is presently unoccupied but was formally used by
2 the State Police and the Bureau of Forestry. The
3 Town of Wells has tried to acquire the parcel of land
4 and building for the last 10 years and plans to con-
5 vert the 50-year old structure into a public safety
6 building. If acquisition is authorized by the Legis-
7 lature for the sum of \$10,000, the town estimates it
8 will cost \$30,000 to repair the building for use by
9 the town.

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
