14 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 15 follows:

16 Sec. 1. 30 MRSA §411, sub-§1, as repealed and 17 replaced by PL 1969, c. 278, is repealed.

18 Sec. 2. 30 MRSA §2225, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 19 1973, c. 64, is repealed.

20 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited 21 in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when 22 approved.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This new draft repeals provisions of the law dealing with the size and type of paper on which annual municipal reports and annual county reports had to be prepared. With this restriction eliminated, less expensive options for printing these reports can be pursued.

30 The original bill repealed the paper requirement 31 for municipal reports only. This new draft adds the 32 repeal of the paper requirement for county reports.
