	7 MRSA §2903, as amended by PL 1981, c. 315, §§10 and 11, is further amended by adding before the last paragraph a new paragraph to read:
į	It is unlawful to sell, offer for sale or expose for sale, any milk or milk product, if the milk or milk product was produced, stored, processed or mandled in a room or place that is insulated with insulation containing formaldehyde.
