The board shall make rules and regulations commensurate with this chapter, subject to the Maine Administrative Procedure Act, Title 5, section 8051 et seq., except as otherwise provided in this subsection, and subject to the approval of the Commissioner of Human Services.
27 28 29 30 31 32 33 34 35 36	The rules and regulations shall include rules and regulations concerning the proper use of appliances, apparatus and electrical machines used in any establishment for or in connection with any of the practices defined in section 301, and prescribing the sanitary requirements to be observed by proprietors of barber shops and schools and by persons engaged in this practice and shall make regulations not contrary to law relative to the applications for licenses and certificates of registration. - such rules and regulations to be printed in suitable form and a copy thereof to be sent to the proprietors of such shops, which copy shall be kept posted in a conspicuous place in such shops so as to be easily read by customers.
- 6 The rules and regulations shall include rules and 7 regulations prescribing the requirements for the construction, operation, maintenance and sanitation of any school of barbering, subject to a license under 8 9 The rules may include reasonable re-10 this chapter. 11 quirements governing the practice of barbering by 12 licensees outside of licensed shops, as permitted by 13 section 302, subsection 2, including proper sanitary 14 requirements.
- 15 The rules and regulations in effect on October 24, 1977, shall be considered temporary rules and regula-16 17 tions. Thereafter, the board shall adopt rules and regulations in accordance with the Maine Administra-18 19 tive Procedure Act, Title 5, section 8051 et seq. 20 Before any rules or regulations can be adopted, the 21 board shall hold a public hearing prior to which it shall send a copy of all proposed rules to all per-22 sons licensed under this chapter. A copy of all rules 23 24 and regulations which are adopted by vote of the 25 board after the hearing and which are approved by the 26 Commissioner of Human Services shall be sent to all 27 persons licensed under this chapter and shall not take effect until 30 days after the date of that vote.' 28 29

The original bill would have permitted the practice of barbering in homes without restriction. Currently, pursuant to statute, the State Board of Barbers, together with the Commissioner of Human Services, regulates the sanitary conditions of barber shops. The purpose of this amendment is to enable continued scrutiny of sanitary conditions by requir-

- giving authority to the board to promulgate reasonable rules governing the practice of barbering out-2
- side of licensed shops.
