20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §302, sub-§2, ¶F, as enacted by
23 PL 1977, c. 398, §3, is amended to read:

24 F. Upon a hotel or motel occupant in that
25 person's hotel or motel room; and

26 Sec. 2. 32 MRSA §302, sub-§2, ¶G is enacted to
27 read:

28 G. Upon a person in the person's residence.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill permits barbers to cut hair in a person's residence when so requested. Cosmetologists already are permitted to conduct their profession in a private residence when so requested.

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
