## STATEMENT OF FACT

Present law provides for moose hunting for a limited number of hunters each year. Because demand for these permits outstrips the number of available permits, a lottery is held to determine who may obtain them.

The purpose of this bill is to assure that the broadest group of people has a chance to obtain these permits or to participate in the hunt as subpermittees. To accomplish this, the bill provides that participants in one year's hunt must sit out one season before being eligible again. Additionally, hunters who are successful in bagging a moose would be required to sit out the next 2 seasons.
