21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
22 follows:

23 1 MRSA §411 is enacted to read:

24 §411. Informal briefings

25 1. Nothing in this chapter may be construed to
26 require informal briefing sessions conducted by a
27 private enterprise for the purpose of confidential
28 disclosure of the plans of that private enterprise be
29 open to the public.

30 2. These informal briefing sessions are not
31 public proceedings as defined by section 402 of this
32 subchapter.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this bill is to make it clear that informal briefing sessions held by private enterprise are not included under the right to know law.

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
