HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 339, L.D. 398,  
Bill, "AN ACT to Authorize Licensees Under the Liquor

Amend the Bill in that part designated "§201." by  
adding at the end the following underlined sentence:

'No licensee by himself or his clerk, servant or  
agent may work as a law enforcement officer on the  
premises that have been licensed to him.'
