Regardless of which payment sched-6 ule is chosen, each register shall have paid the 7 8 entire montly amount for his county to his county treasurer by the 15th day of the following month. 9 10 They may make abstracts and copies from the records 11 and furnish the same to persons calling for them and may charge a reasonable fee for such service, but 12 shall not give an opinion upon the title to real 13 14 estate.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to grant county 16 registers of deeds the flexibility to account for and 17 18 pay over, to county treasurers, the fees they receive on either a weekly or monthly basis. This bill main-19 tains the changes instituted by Public Law 1981, 20 21 chapter 40, section 6 by requiring that all funds ac-22 quired during the month be paid over to county treasurers by the 15th of the following month, regardless 23 of which payment schedule is followed. 24
