17 AN ACT to Permit an Air National Guard
18 Officer to be Eligible to Serve as
19 Deputy Adjutant General.

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
22 follows:

23 37-A MRSA §214, 7th ¶, as repealed and replaced
24 by PL 1973, c. 709, §3, is amended to read:

25 The Adjutant General may appoint, subject to the
26 approval of the Governor, an assistant adjutant gen-
27 eral for the Army National Guard, ~~who shall be the~~
28 ~~Deputy Adjutant General,~~ and an assistant adjutant
29 general for the Air National Guard. ~~Such assistant~~
30 ~~adjutant general~~ Either assistant adjutant general
31 may be appointed the Deputy Adjutant General and he
32 may hold the grade of Brigadier General and shall
33 serve at the will and pleasure of the Adjutant Gen-
34 eral. An assistant adjutant general shall meet the

1 qualifications set forth in section 213. Each assis-
2 tant adjutant general shall be responsible for the
3 general supervision of training and administration of
4 the affairs of the Army National Guard and Air
5 National Guard, respectively, and for such other
6 duties as are prescribed by the Adjutant General.

7 STATEMENT OF FACT

8 The purpose of this bill is to permit the Deputy
9 Adjutant General to be drawn from the ranks of either
10 the Army National Guard or the Air National Guard.
11 Currently, only an officer from the Army National
12 Guard may serve as Deputy Adjutant General.
