17 AN ACT Concerning Synchronized Traffic  
18 Lights.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
21 follows:

22 29 MRSA §947, sub-§4-A is enacted to read:

23 4-A. Synchronization of traffic-control signals.  
24 Whenever 2 or more official traffic-control signals  
25 are installed or replaced on any street or road in  
26 any municipality, those traffic-control signals shall  
27 be synchronized, as much as is practicable, to ensure  
28 the uninterrupted flow of traffic along that street  
29 or road.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this bill is to provide that whenever possible traffic lights within municipalities should be synchronized to allow for the uninterrupted flow of traffic.

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
