17 AN ACT Relating to Use of Red and Blue
18 Lights on Certain Motor Vehicles.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 29 MRSA §1368, sub-§2, as amended by PL 1973, c.
23 31, is further amended to read:

24 2. Police department vehicles. Lights used on
25 police department vehicles and on motor vehicles
26 operated by chiefs of police, state fire inspectors,
27 inland fisheries and game wildlife wardens, sea and
28 shore fisheries wardens, Baxter State Park rangers,
29 sheriffs and deputy sheriffs shall emit a blue beam
30 of light or a combination of red and blue beams in
31 equal proportions.

STATEMENT OF FACT

1
2 The intent of this bill is to extend the author-
3 ity to use a blue beam of light on certain vehicles
4 to include a combination of red and blue beams in
5 equal proportions to increase the visibility of these
6 vehicles.
