AN ACT to Increase the Percentage of
State Municipal Revenue Sharing from 4% to 6%.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, state-municipal revenue sharing funds are to be transferred by the Treasurer of State to the Local Government Fund beginning on July 1, 1983; and

Whereas, any increase in the percentage of state-municipal revenue sharing should take effect prior to July 1, 1983, in order that those funds may be transferred beginning July 1, 1983; and

Whereas, unless this legislation is enacted as emergency legislation, it will not take effect prior to July 1, 1983; and
