17 AN ACT to Provide Representatives for  
18 Owners of Certified Barber Hair Styling  
19 Schools on the State Board of Barbers.  
20

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
22 follows:

23 Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §351, sub-§1, as enacted by PL  
24 1977, c. 398, §7, is amended to read:

25 1. Membership. The State Board of Barbers, as  
26 heretofore established and in this chapter designated  
27 as the "board," shall consist of 5 members who shall  
28 be citizens of this State, ~~3~~ 2 of whom shall have  
29 been engaged in the practice of barbering for at  
30 least 3 years immediately prior to their appointment,  
31 one of whom shall be an owner of a certified school  
32 of barbering and styling and one of whom shall be a  
33 representative of the public. The 5th member of the  
34 board shall be the Director of Health who shall have  
35 no board vote.

1 The 4 voting members of the board shall be appointed  
2 by the Governor and their terms shall be for 3 years.  
3 None of them ~~shall~~ may be eligible to serve more than  
4 3 consecutive 3-year terms. The barber members shall  
5 at all times be registered barbers.

6 Any vacancy in the board shall be filled by the  
7 appointment by the Governor of a person to hold  
8 office during the unexpired term. The person  
9 appointed shall be qualified in the same manner as  
10 the board member being replaced. No person operating  
11 or employed by a school of barbering ~~shall~~ may be  
12 appointed as a member of the board. If any member of  
13 the board, after appointment, shall become affiliated  
14 in any way with any such school, that person's  
15 membership on the board shall immediately terminate  
16 and the unexpired term of that member shall be filled  
17 by the Governor.

18 Sec. 2. Transition. Any member of the board,  
19 serving as of the effective date of this Act, may  
20 complete his term and upon the first vacancy of the  
21 board, involving the members of the board who are  
22 barbers, an appointment shall be made so that an  
23 owner of a certified school of barbering and styling  
24 is a member of the board.

25 STATEMENT OF FACT

26 The purpose of this bill is to adjust the member-  
27 ship of the State Board of Barbers so that one of the  
28 members of the board is an owner of a certified  
29 school of barbering and styling. Owners of schools  
30 presently have no representation on the board.
