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Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, recodifies the education laws of this State; and

Whereas, the Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, is to take effect July 1, 1983; and

Whereas, this legislation is designed to amend that Title; and

Whereas, unless enacted as an emergency measure, this legislation will not take effect until approximately 3 months after July 1, 1983, thereby causing confusion among the educational community; and
