intoxicating liquor in his possession except in the scope of his or her employment on any street or highway, or in any public place or in any automobile, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of net mere no less than \$100 nor more than \$300 for the first offense; not less than \$50 \$200 nor more than \$100 for the 2nd offense; and \$100 \$500 for the 3rd and subsequent offenses. If a minor is charged with illegal possession under this section, he may not be charged with illegal transportation. No minor shall may be charged with more than one offense under this section in any given instance wherein the same set of facts is involved.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

 The purpose of this bill is to establish minimum and maximum fines for any person under 20 years of age who commits a fraudulant act.
