21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
22 follows:

23 5 MRSA §1124, sub-§5 is enacted to read:

24 5. Applicability. Notwithstanding section 1033,  
25 subsection 3, the provisions of this section in  
26 effect on June 30, 1982, with the exception of sub-  
27 section 4, are applicable to each participating local  
28 district which has adopted this section as part of  
29 its plan regardless of whether or not the district  
30 has adopted amendments enacted subsequent to its  
31 adoption of this section as part of its plan.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this bill is to allow a more standard and uniform application of Title 5, section 1124, ordinary death benefits, to all members of the Maine State Retirement System.

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
