STATEMENT OF FACT

8 This bill provides for an automatic warranty of 9 fitness for use under the used car information laws. 10 Any mechanical defect that affects the vehicle's 11 safety or normal use, if detected and reported within 12 60 days of transfer, is required to be repaired or 13 replaced by the dealer.

14 The bill further provides for a disclaimer of 15 this warranty by dealers in cases where the purchaser 16 is specifically informed that this may result in dif-17 ficulties in claiming a right to services from the 18 dealer.

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
