	AN ACT to Prohibit Hazing on College
	Campuses and on Property Used for
	Educational Purposes.
	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
	follows:
	20-A MRSA §10004 is enacted to read:
	§10004. Regulation of conduct on campuses and on
	property used for educational purposes
	The trustees or other governing board of every
	post-secondary institution incorporated or chartered
	under the laws of this State shall adopt rules for
	the maintenance of public order on the campus of the
	institution and other institution property used for
	educational purposes, prohibiting any action or
	situation which recklessly or intentionally endangers
	mental or physical health for the purpose of initia-

1 tion into or affiliation with any organization. The 2 penalties for violation of these rules shall be 3 clearly set forth and shall include provisions for 4 the ejection of a violator from the campus or prop-5 erty, in the case of a student or faculty violator, 6 his suspension, expulsion or other appropriate disci-7 plinary action and, in the case of an organization which authorizes this conduct, recision of permission 8 9 for that organization to operate on campus property. 10 These penalties shall be in addition to any other 11 civil or criminal penalty to which the violator or organization may be subject. 12

13 A copy of the rules which prohibit reckless or 14 intentional endangerment to health for the purpose of 15 initiation into or affiliation with any organization 16 shall be given to all students enrolled in the insti-17 tution and shall be deemed to be part of the bylaws of all organizations operating on the campus and the 18 organization shall annually review these bylaws with 19 20 individuals affiliated with the organizations.

STATEMENT OF FACT

22 this bill is to require The purpose of 23 post-secondary institutions to institute rules to control certain practices of organization on their 24 25 campuses relating to initiation or affiliation with 26 the organizations, where these practices endanger the 27 mental or physical health of the persons being ini-28 tiated.

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
