**AN ACT to Increase Reimbursement for
Professional Credits for Teachers.**

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, there are certain changes that are vitally needed in the education laws; and

Whereas, the new education laws enacted under Public Law 1981, chapter 693, will take effect on July 1, 1983; and

Whereas, needed changes to existing laws will conflict with emergence of the new laws, unless passed as an emergency; and
