16 17 18 19	Further amend the Bill in that part designated "§901." by striking out all of subsection 3 (page 2, lines 7 to 9 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:
20 21 22	'3. Coordinating volunteers. To help individual school units in developing mechanisms for coordinating volunteer efforts in their schools; and
23 24 25 26	4. Other activities. To stimulate the development and implementation of other activities which will supplement the activities of the existing staff in the school administrative unit.
27 28 29 30	Further amend the Bill in the part designated "§902." by striking out all of the underlined paragraph (page 2, lines 13 to 17 in L.D) and inserting in its place the following:
31 32 33 34 35	'The department shall contract to carry out the purposes of this chapter, as set forth in section 901, and shall seek the advice of the Maine School Volunteer Alliance in establishing the criteria to be met.'
