COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 386,
L.D. 469, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide a Statewide
Office of School Volunteer Programs."

Amend the Bill in that part designated "§901.",
in subsection 2, in the last line, (page 2, line 6 in
L.D.) by striking out the underlined punctuation and
word ";" and inserting in their place the under-
line punctuation and words ', including, but not
limited to, record keeping, health screening and
copying;'

Further amend the Bill in that part designated
"§901." by striking out all of subsection 3 (page 2,
lines 7 to 9 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the
following:

'3. Coordinating volunteers. To help individual
school units in developing mechanisms for coordi-
nating volunteer efforts in their schools; and

4. Other activities. To stimulate the develop-
ment and implementation of other activities which
will supplement the activities of the existing staff
in the school administrative unit.'

Further amend the Bill in the part designated
"§902." by striking out all of the underlined para-
graph (page 2, lines 13 to 17 in L.D) and inserting
in its place the following:

'The department shall contract to carry out the
purposes of this chapter, as set forth in section
901, and shall seek the advice of the Maine School
Volunteer Alliance in establishing the criteria to be
met.'

14 volunteers; and
- 15 4. The department responsibility to "seek the
16 advice of" rather than "consult with" the Maine
17 School Volunteer Alliance.
