18 from Deer Damage.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 12 MRSA §7506 is enacted to read:

23 §7506. Damage by deer to horticultural nurseries

24 If the commissioner determines that it is impos-
25 sible to prevent deer from causing damage to a horti-
26 cultural nursery, he may enter into an agreement with
27 the owner of the horticultural nursery whereby the
28 department shall assume 1/2 of the cost of fencing
29 the nursery.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this bill is to provide that the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife may, if he determines that it is impossible to prevent deer from doing damage to a horticultural nursery, enter into an agreement with the owner to provide that the department will assume 1/2 of the cost of fencing the nursery.

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
