17 AN ACT Relating to Attendants for
18 Power Boilers.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 26 MRSa §218 is enacted to read:

23 §218. Attendants for power boilers

24 A power boiler having a rating of either 5 horse-
25 power or 50 square feet of heat absorbing surface
26 shall not be operated for periods longer than 20 min-
27 utes without being checked by an attendant who is
28 familiar with its operation, whether or not the
29 boiler is equipped with automatic feedwater
30 regulator, fuel or damper regulator, high and low
31 water alarm or other form of automatic control.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The purpose of this bill is to require that power
3 boilers with a rating of either 5 horsepower or 50
4 square feet of heat absorbing surface be checked by
5 an attendant at least once every 20 minutes.

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
