21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
22 follows:

23 35 MRSA §1199 is enacted to read:

24 §1199. Railroad cars; reflectors

25 Any railroad company organized under the laws of
26 this State shall display on each railroad car owned
27 or leased by the company and used within this State
28 reflectors or reflectorized material in such a manner
29 that the reflectors or reflectorized material is vis-
30 ible from both sides of the car.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this bill is to require that Maine
railroads display reflectors or reflectorized mate-
rial on all railroad cars owned or operated by them
within the State.

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
