17 AN ACT to Improve the Identification  
18 of Persons Trying to Evade State Taxes.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
21 follows:

22 36 MRSA §193 is enacted to read:

23 §193. Tax evasion information

24 1. Toll-free telephone line. The bureau shall  
25 maintain a toll-free telephone line for the purpose  
26 of receiving information relating to tax evasion.

27 2. Finder's fee. Any person who makes a report  
28 to the bureau shall be entitled to a finder's fee in  
29 the amount of \$50 for each report that results in the  
30 discovery of tax evasion. When more than one person  
31 makes a report, about a suspected tax evader, the  
32 first in time shall receive the fee.
