18 for Sales to Certain Humane Societies.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 36 MRSA §1760, sub-§42 is enacted to read:

23 42. Humane societies. Sales to any humane
24 society which:

25 A. Is exempt from taxation under the United
26 States Internal Revenue Code, Section 501;

27 B. Is a member of the Maine Federation of Humane
28 Societies; and

29 C. Has no officer or director or any member of
30 the immediate family of any officer or director
31 who receives any pecuniary profit from the opera-
