- 3 Sec. 2. 29 MRSA §246, 4th ¶, as amended by PL 4 1973, c. 614, §2, is further amended to read:

The term "agricultural commodities" shall include logs, lumber and pulpwood cut on a farm or farms owned by the registrant. Farm or fishing motor trucks registered under this section may receive a short-term permit in accordance with this section by paying a percentage of the difference between the amount paid for farm or fishing motor truck registration and the annual fee for the desired tonnage in accordance with the permit table contained in this section.

Sec. 3. 29 MRSA §246, 5th ¶ is amended to read:

The Secretary of State shall issue a registration plate or plates so designed that a farm or fishing motor truck registered under this section may be distinguished from commercial vehicles otherwise registered under this section. Trucks which are used on a substantially daily delivery schedule on established routes are not included as "farm trucks." Any person fraudulently obtaining a farm or fishing truck license shall be fined upon conviction \$50. Any person using a truck with a license plate marked for any purposes other than those authorized by this section shall be fined not less than \$100 nor more than \$500.

Sec. 4. 29 MRSA §246, last ¶, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 623, §44-A, is amended to read:

On any application by an owner of a farm or fishing motor truck having 2 or 3 axles, when such trucks are used primarily for transportation of agricultural produce, grown by the owner on his farm or farms, or when used primarily to catch, harvest or transport fish or any marine animals with the intent of disposing of them for profit or trade in commercial channels, 1/2 the registration fee may be charged during the last 6 months of a registration year.

A. Any farm or fishing truck subject to partial inspection shall bear the name of the town in which the excise tax is paid in 4-inch letters on the left door of the cab of the truck; and

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to allow persons engaged in fishing to take advantage of the special motor vehicle registration and inspection provisions available to farm trucks.
