Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after 13 14 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and 15 Whereas, it is possible that appointments will be made to the Harness Racing Commission prior to 90 16 days after the adjournment of the Legislature; and 17 Whereas, unless this legislation is enacted as emergency legislation, those appointments will not be 18 19 20 subject to legislative confirmation; and 21 Whereas, in order to provide for equitable application of this legislation, it is important that it 22 23 be applied to all appointments made to the commission 24 after the passage of this bill; and 25 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of 26 27 the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-vation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 28 29 30 therefore, Further amend the bill in that part designated 31 "§261." by striking out in the 6th line (page 1, line 32 29 in L.D.) the underlined words, punctuation and figures "Commencing January 1, 1987, all" and insert-33 34 ing in their place the underlined word 'All'
