17 AN ACT to Require that Persons must
18 Serve an Apprenticeship before they may be
19 Issued a Lobster Fishing License.

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
22 follows:

23 12 MRSA §6422 is enacted to read:

24 §6422. Restrictions on issuance of license

25 A lobster and crab fishing license may not be
26 issued to any person who has never held such a li-
27 cence before, unless:

28 1. Apprenticeship. The applicant furnishes, at
29 the time of application, adequate evidence that he
30 has served at least a one-year apprenticeship as
31 sternman for a person who has held a valid lobster
32 and crab fishing license for at least 5 years; or
