20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 26 MRSA §965, sub-§1, ¶C, as enacted by PL 1969,
23 c. 424, §1, is amended to read:

24 C. To confer and negotiate in good faith with
25 respect to wages, hours, working conditions and
26 contract grievance arbitration, except that by

28 pelled to agree to a proposal or be required to

30 ~~ers of teachers shall meet and consult but not~~

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this bill is to provide to teachers employed in public schools the same collective bargaining rights as apply to all other municipal public employees.

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
