20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 26 MRSA §1026, sub-§1, ¶E, as enacted by PL 1975,
23 c. 603, §1, is amended to read:

24 E. To participate in good faith in the media-
25 tion, fact finding and arbitration procedures re-
26 quired by this section.

27 STATEMENT OF FACT

28 The purpose of this bill is to require the parties
29 to participate in good faith in fact-finding
30 procedures and makes this statute, which applies to
31 University of Maine employees and other schools, con-

1 sistent with other statutes applicable to educational
2 bargaining.

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
