17 RESOLVE, Approving the 1983 Draft
18 and Arrangement of the Constitution of Maine
19 Made by the Chief Justice of the Supreme Judicial
20 Court and Providing for its Publication and
21 Distribution.

23 Constitution; approval of 1983 draft and
24 arrangement, enrollment, publication, distribution.
25 Resolved: That the draft and arrangement of the Con-
26 stitution of Maine, as amended, made by the Chief
27 Justice of the Supreme Judicial Court, in pursuance
28 of the Constitution of Maine, Article X, Section 6,
29 is approved, and that the same be enrolled on
30 parchment or other suitable material and deposited in
31 the office of the Secretary of State; and be it fur-
32 ther

33 Resolved: That the Secretary of State is
34 authorized and directed to cause the Constitution of
35 Maine, as amended and arranged, to be enrolled on

1 parchment, or other suitable material and upon final
2 approval of the Chief Justice, attest to the cor-
3 rectness of that enrollment under the seal of the
4 State; and be it further

5 **Resolved:** That the Secretary of State is
6 authorized and directed to cause to be published in
7 pamphlet form, subject to approval of the Chief Jus-
8 tice, copies of the Constitution of Maine, in such
9 numbers as he deems necessary, and that one copy of
10 the same be forwarded to the municipal officers of
11 each city and town and to the assessors of each
12 plantation within the State.

13 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

14 The purpose of this resolve is to approve the
15 1983 draft and arrangement of the Constitution of
16 Maine made by the Chief Justice of the Supreme Judi-
17 cial Court, and provide for its publication and dis-
18 tribution.
