7 HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" 8 to H.P. 460, L.D. 562, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for 9 an Analysis of the Future of Maine's Forest 10 Resources."

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 2 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 2. Steering committee established. There is a steering committee established, the members of which are to be selected by a panel consisting of the Commissioner of Conservation who shall act as chairman of the selection panel and shall call the initial meeting of the steering committee, the Dean of the College of Forest Resources of the University of Maine and the Vice-President of the American Forest Institute. The steering committee shall be composed of 10 to 12 members who shall be representatives of all segments of the forestry community and forestry interests. In addition, 5 members of the House of Representatives shall be appointed by the Speaker of the House and 3 members of the Senate shall be appointed by the President of the Senate. Steering committee members, other than members of the Legislature, shall further be those individuals with knowledge, experience and interest in the forest resources of the State. The chairman of the committee shall be selected by the committee members.'
