STATEMENT OF FACT

United States Public Law 94-142, the Education of
All Handicapped Children's Act includes a requirement
that all educational programs for handicapped stu-
dents be under the general supervision of the Depart-
ment of Educational and Cultural Services. The com-
missioner will have general supervisory responsibil-
ity for all programs including those administered by
other state and local agencies. All programs will be
monitored to determine their compliance with state
and federal regulations.

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
