2 3 4 5 6 7 8	This amendment makes several technical changes to definitions. The amendment also changes several definitions enacted by L.D. 313 to make them consistent with other statutes. Finally, the amendment deletes the section of the bill moving hazardous waste transport fees from the General Fund to the Maine Hazardous Waste Fund, as it is contained in another bill.
