20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 Sec. 1. 17-A MRSA §1256, sub-§1, as enacted by
23 PL 1981, c. 324, §34, is amended to read:

24 1. Other provisions of this section notwith-
25 standing, when a person subject to an undischarged
26 term of imprisonment is convicted of a violation of
27 ~~section~~ sections 755 and 757, or of a crime against
28 the person of a member of the staff of the institu-
29 tion in which he the convicted person was imprisoned,
30 or of an attempt to commit either of such crimes any
31 of the crimes mentioned in this section, the sentence
32 shall run consecutively to the undischarged term of
33 imprisonment. No portion of this sentence may be sus-
34 pended.
