17 AN ACT to Amend the Charter of St.  
18 Mark's Home in Augusta.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
21 follows:

22 P&SL 1871, c. 560, §1, as amended by P&SL 1981,  
23 c. 96, is further amended to read:

24 Sec. 1. Corporators; name; real and personal  
25 property; purpose. The rector, wardens and vestry of  
26 St. Mark's Church, Augusta, and their successors in  
27 office, are hereby constituted a body corporate and  
28 politic, by the name of St. Mark's Home for Women,  
29 with authority to take and hold property, real and  
30 personal, for establishing and maintaining in said  
31 Augusta, a home for women, of the value of \$300,000,  
32 and to manage and control the same home for the purpose  
33 aforesaid; and said the corporation shall have  
34 all the powers and privileges and be subject to all

1 the duties and liabilities of similar corporations in  
2 this State. The corporation, as a charitable and  
3 nonprofit corporation, shall be tax exempt under the  
4 Revised Statutes, Title 36, section 652.

5 STATEMENT OF FACT

6 This bill amends the charter of St. Mark's Home  
7 for Women, in Augusta, to clarify its tax exempt  
8 status.
