STATEMENT OF FACT

The Department of Labor, Division of Employment currently makes approximately 50,000 bene-Security, fit determinations per year. On each determination, the claimant is notified of the section of the statute under which the determination has been made. addition to the statute itself, the department personnel rely on a body of rules and department polideveloped internally, on such diverse topics as when work is suitable, what circumstances constitute nondisqualifying illness, etc. Although these rules and policies are used to govern eligibility and benefit payment, they are not accessible to claimants assist them in understanding their benefit determination and deciding whether or not to appeal. they are not collected, indexed or otherwise available in a comprehensive manner to be used internally to insure consistency in benefit determination throughout the State.
