Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-
lature do not become effective until 90 days after
adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, municipalities are confronting financial
problems in meeting their responsibilities for high-
way maintenance and repair; and

Whereas, the State has assumed responsibility
after an extensive reclassification effort for 129.24
miles of road that was previously the responsibility
of municipal governments in Maine; and
