17 AN ACT to Eliminate Discrimination against  
18 Retired Maine Residents who have  
19 Previously been Members of the  
20 Maine State Retirement System.  
21

22 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
23 follows:

24 5 MRSA §1123, as amended by PL 1979, c. 663, §§16  
25 and 17, is further amended by adding at the end a new  
26 paragraph to read:

27 Any person who is a recipient of a state retire-  
28 ment allowance and who is reemployed in any capacity  
29 in which he would otherwise be eligible to be a  
30 participating member of the system may, as of January  
31 1, 1983, become a member of the system providing that  
32 his new service shall entitle that person to new benef-  
33 fits. Any new benefits shall be only such benefits  
34 as one earned on the new service and shall not

1 entitle any person so reemployed to statutory minimum  
2 benefits on that service nor shall benefits earned  
3 previously be recomputed because of the new service  
4 in the system.

5 STATEMENT OF FACT

6 The purpose of this bill is to permit persons who  
7 are receiving a state retirement allowance to become  
8 members of the Maine State Retirement System if they  
9 are reemployed and entitled to new benefits.
