The board, as heretofore established, subsection 6. shall consist of the Treasurer of State or his designee, ex officio, as a nonvoting member; a member duly elected by the Maine Teachers' Association; a member duly elected by the Maine State Employees' Associa-3 persons appointed by the Governor, and subtion; ject to review by the Joint Standing Committee Aging, Veterans and Retirement Retirement and Veterans and to confirmation by the Legislature at least 2 of whom shall be qualified through training experience in the field of investments, accounting, banking, insurance or law, and one of whom shall selected from a list of 3 nominees submitted by the Maine Retired Teachers' Association; a person who a member of the Maine State Retirement System through participating local district and who shall be appointed by the governing body of the Maine Municipal Association; a person who is the recipient of a retirement allowance through the Maine State Retire-System and who shall be selected by the foregoing members of the board of trustees from a list lists of nominees submitted by retired state employees and retired participating local district employor by a committee comprised of representatives and by the Maine Association of of said groups designee of the Treasurer of State Retirees.
