AN ACT to Make Allocations from the
Alcoholism Prevention, Education,
Treatment and Research Fund for the
Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 1983.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the 90-day period will not terminate until after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and

Whereas, certain obligations and expenses incident to the operation of the department will become due and payable on or immediately after July 1, 1983; and

1 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,
2 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of
3 the Constitution of Maine and require the following
4 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-
5 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
6 therefore,

7 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
8 follows:

9 Allocation of Alcoholism Prevention, Education,
10 Treatment and Research Fund. Income to the Alcohol-
11 ism Prevention, Education, Treatment and Research
12 Fund for the current fiscal year from July 1, 1982,
13 to June 30, 1983, shall be segregated, apportioned
14 and disbursed as designated in the following sched-

22 This Act makes a supplemental
23 allocation from the Alcoholism
24 Prevention, Education, Treatment
25 and Research Fund. Allocations
26 are required by Public Law 1981,
27 chapter 454.

28 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited
29 in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when
30 approved.

31 STATEMENT OF FACT

32 The purpose of this bill is reflected in the
33 emergency preamble.
