17 AN ACT to Promote Safe Solid
18 Fuel Burning Practices.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 Sec. 1. 25 MRSA §2465, sub-§5-A is enacted to
23 read:

24 5-A. Safety information. No factory-built
25 fireplace, fireplace stove or solid fuel burning room
26 heater may be sold in retail trade, unless the seller
27 provides the buyer, on or before the sale, with an
28 installation instruction manual or, in the case where
29 such a manual is not available, with a publication of
30 the Office of Energy Resources containing recommended
31 clearances the same as those prescribed in the
32 National Fire Protection Association Code #211, The
33 Standards for Chimneys, Fireplaces, Vents and Solid
34 Fuel Burning Appliances, as approved by the office of
35 the State Fire Marshal.
