Ski or otherwise use a slope 4. or trail which has been designated "closed" by the 14 15 operator without written permission of the operator 16 or his designee; er Sec. 3. 26 MRSA §489, sub-§5, as enacted by PL 17 1979, c. 514, §5, is amended to read: 18 19 5. Removal or destruction of signs. Remove, 20 alter, deface or destroy any sign or notice placed in the ski area or on the trail by the operator; or 21 22 Sec. 4. 26 MRSA §489, sub-§6 is enacted to read: 23 Out-of-bounds areas. Ski or otherwise use 6. 24 any portion of the ski area that is not a part of a regular network of trails or areas open to the public, including wooded areas between trails, 25 26 undeveloped areas and all other portions not open to 27 the public, if the operator has properly posted these 28 29 areas as being closed to public access. 30 Further amend the Bill by renumbering section 3 31 to be section 5.
