22 23 24 25 26 27 28	The purpose of this amendment is to reorganize the amendment language in the Constitution of Maine, Article IV, Part 3, Section 23, to avoid a technical conflict with another Constitutional Resolution under consideration and to split the question to appear on the ballot into 2 questions in order to avoid confusion of the voters.
