STATEMENT OF FACT

The appointment of the Commissioner of Educational and Cultural Services from a list prepared by the State Board of Education has proven to be costly, ineffective and time consuming. In 1979, 2 acting commissioners had to be appointed before a new commissioner was selected in August. The lengthy delay created a leadership vacuum in the department, which will be avoided whenever there are vacancies in the office of the commissioner if this bill is enacted.

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
