Amend the Bill by striking out all of the first  
paragraph after the amending clause and inserting in  
its place the following:

'In a municipality where the State Liquor Commis-  
sion operates a state liquor store in which the  
inhabitants of the municipality have not previously  
voted upon the question in subsection 5, the State  
Liquor Commission may request that the municipality  
vote upon that question by sending a written request  
for a vote to the municipal officials. If the municip-  
al officials agree to the commission's request, they  
may proceed by following the procedures established  
in this section. No subsequent vote may be taken on  
the question in subsection 5, except by petition of  
the inhabitants of the municipality.'

Under the original version of the bill, municipal  
officials had to vote on the Sunday opening question  
if the State Liquor Commission requested it. This  
amendment changes that provision so that municipal  
officials may choose whether or not to agree to hold  
a vote on the question in Title 28, section 101, sub-  
section 5.
