The report shall contain recommendations. For regular and special sessions of the next begislature; for all compensation of Legislators and representatives of Indian tribes, including, but not to, all payments for salaries, for meals, housing, travel, mileage and all other expenses and allowances; for additional services as President of the Senate, Speaker of the House, and as a member leadership; and for constituent services. The report shall also contain recommendations for compensation for the Attorney General, the Secretary of State, the Freasurer of State and the State Auditor: The report may contain other recommendations. The report contain recommendations for: All compensation of justices and judges, constitutional officers, Legis-lators, Clerk of the House of Representatives, Secretary of State and representatives of Indian tribes, including, but not limited to, all payments for salaries, meals, housing, travel, mileage, constituent services and all other expenses and allowances, including additional payments made for additional services by any justice, judge, constitutional officer, President of the Senate, Speaker of the House of Representatives and members of legislative leadership. The report may contain other recommendations.
